

Title: Improving the Public Distribution of Essential Medicines in Sub-Saharan Africa: The Case of Zambia

Abstract: Despite successful improvements efforts by the government and partners, the public pharmaceutical distribution system in Zambia still results in low service levels relative to private sector standards. We present an alternative design involving mobile devices and optimization. Simulation results suggest that it would increase drug availability and reduce inventory costs.
