Submission Information

Interested participants are invited to submit abstracts of continuous text (no bullet points, no math/Greek symbols) no longer than 50 words describing their presentation. The title should be no longer than 15 words. Submissions should include information about all co-authors including full name, organization, and contact email. The system will also ask to identify the name of the paper presenter.

- The conference website will be available for abstract submission on Tuesday, October 18, 2022.
- The last date to submit abstracts is Thursday, December 15, 2022.
- The colleges' mini conferences will be held on Sunday, May 21, 2023.
- The main conference will be held from Monday, May 22 through Thursday, May 25, 2023
