Submission Information

Interested participants are invited to submit abstracts of continuous text (no bullet points, no math/Greek symbols) no longer than 50 words describing their presentation. The title should be no longer than 15 words. Submissions should include information about all co-authors including full name, organization, and contact email. The system will also ask to identify the name of the paper presenter.

- The conference website will be available for abstract submission on Friday, September 15, 2023.
- The last date to submit abstracts is Wednesday, November 15, 2023.
- The colleges' mini conferences will be held on Thursday, April 25, 2024.
- The main conference will be held from Friday, April 26 through Monday, April 29, 2024

One person can present at most three papers. See important dates and frequently asked questions on the conference website after the abstract submission system opens.
